Dry, with aromas of green apple, lemon, tropical fruit, and nettles packed with flavour on the palate, but yet light, dry and very fresh. 2030	Pouilly Fume Les Berthiers Claude Michot A small grower with a real passion for his terroir, Claude Michot produces a wine that is very typical of St Andelain - a hamlet made famous by the late, great Didier Dagueneau - in that it has a flinty, almost 'capgun' smoke scented nose and racy acidity. Claude is a pretty busy man though as he does it all on his own - this allows him to be completely uncompromising in his pursuit of excellence and consistency. From pure Sauvignon Blanc this wine is light and crisp, and has intense, citrus and peach aromas with a minerally finish	2010	Loire	France	46

2110	Chablis Domaine Vrignaud 100% Chardonnay, 1 g/l residual sugar and not a whiff of oak, this is as pure a traditional flinty Chablis as you can get. Domaine Vrignaud in Fontenay, is managed by the family with Guillaume Vrignaud (son) responsible for making the wines. Guillaume is incredibly passionate about the land they farm, they have used no fertilizers for over 20 years, no longer use any pesticides and have been experimenting with the organic treatments championed in bio-dynamics. All of these factors have a huge impact on the vine, lowering yields, lowering ph and prolonging the ripening period allowing for better balance in the wines and heightened acidity levels. The grapes for all of their wines are hand picked and hand sorted.	2013	Burgundy	France	46
2120	Patrick Piuze Chablis 1er Cru Montée de Tonnerre Patrick Piuze is something of an outsider in Chablis. A French-Canadian by birth, he caught the wine bug whilst managing a bar in Montreal and soon decided he wanted to get his hands dirty in the vineyards. After spells working for Verget and Olivier Leflaive, Patrick struck out on his own in 2008 setting up a micro-negociant business in Chablis. He is already regarded as one of the region's hottest winemaking talents. This light-bodied, fresh white wine has aromas and flavours of honeysuckle, pear, peach and apple, alongside notes of toasty brioche. The wine is elegant and complex, with a fruity refreshing finish. From a single parcel of 70 year-old vines located on the right bank of the Serein River, the grapes are harvested and then fermented over 3 months in 8-year-old French oak barrels. 100% malolactic fermentation is carried out in order to give the wine a smooth, round mouthfeel.	2013	Burgundy	France	99
2125	Macon Villages Cave de Lugny Founded in 1927, Cooperative Vinicole de Lugny was the second cooperative created in the Maconnais region. By collecting a communal harvest, the idea was to not only emancipate the winegrowers from the guardianship of the merchant houses, but to also liberate them from the weight of heavy investments while at the same time inciting a qualitative improvement of the harvest. 	Stunningly good value wine from the Domaine Alain Roy. Purely stainless steel production with no oak used at all makes this a crisp and clean wine with aromas of white flowers and hints of apricot fruit and abounding with minerality. The production methods used ensure that this wine is suitable for people following a Vegan or Vegetarian diet.				
276	Rully 1er Cru Les Cloux	2010	Burgundy	France	38
	Hélène Jaeger-defaix took over the first vineyard from her aunt in October 2002 in hope that she would one day take over all of the 4.5 hectares of prestigious first crus of Rully. She wanted to continue the viticultural tradition from her great grandfather Henri Niece, a well recognised man in the heart of Rully. This is considered one of the foremost estates of the Rully appellation. This vintage is drinking perfectly now and has notes of passionfruit and papaya, subtle aromas of brioche and pine with a palate that keeps evolving with great depth. It is intense without excessive weight and finishes with a wave of minerality.

	This is a Chateau the Courseille family purchased 14 years ago just down the road from Thieuley in the Entre-Deux-Mers region. What is a particular characteristic of this estate is the addition of Sauvignon Gris to the Sauvignon blend and the high proportion of Semillon. The combination of varieties gives the wine so much character and structure. The Gris gives body and density, the Semillon acidity and minerality, the Sauvignon unsurprisingly aromatics but there are none of the tinned asparagus or leafy flavours sometimes associated to Sauvignon.

2210	Crozes Hermitage Blanc Les Jalets Paul Jaboulet Aine	2013	Rhone	France	49
	Since the early 19th century Paul Jaboulet Aine has been synonymous with quality wine in the Rhone. In 1834, Antoine Jaboulet (1807-1864) started working the land in this region, creating a lasting link between the Jaboulet name and the Rhone over the generations. 100% Marsanne grapes harvested by hand into 25kg crates, then pressed directly so as to minimise the danger of oxidation, the wines are vinified in casks for 30% of the blend. Malolactic fermentation is carried out in barrels and stirring enables the lees to remain in suspension. For the wines in vats, this malolactic fermentation occurs in the vats.

Only native varieties are planted here, including Gros Manseng and Petit Manseng. Both varieties are known for their electrifying acidity, a necessary trait given the clay soils on which they are planted. Clay adds richness and depth to wines so the varieties are well placed at Domaine Cauhape to pick up these complementary characteristics. The Gros Manseng & Camaralet grapes for this wine are hand-harvested in small quantities at the beginning of October, de-stemmed, followed by whole bunch maceration for 12 hours and then gently crushed in pneumatic press. There follows a selection of juice (first pressing) and then maturation in stainless steel tanks on the fine lees for a period of 6 months.</p>

One of the leading estates in Piemonte, the Morgassi Superiore winery was created by Marino Piacitelli in 1993 and produces excellent wines from Cortese and Timorasso grapes grown in the terroir of Piemonte's finest vineyards. Produced in limited quantities, Morgassi wines are some of the finest examples of Gavi found anywhere in the region. The grapes for this wine are chilled in a cold store for 12 hours overnight after harvesting, they are then destemmed and soft pressed. The grapes are fermented and refined in stainless steel vats and then refined in bottle at least 4 months.

	This wine is produced from the Cortese grape at the unique low alpine region of Piedmont which means 'at the foot of the mountains'. The climate here gives Gavi its specific 'flinty-ness' with good minerals and also aromas of vanilla. Drinks well with seafood and white fish.

	There are family-run boutique wineries, and then there is Suavia. Everything at this estate is done by one of the four Tessari sisters who have taken over from their parents. With plenty of hard work, Arianna, Meri, Valentina and Alessandra have taken Suavia on to the next level where it can rightly be regarded as one of the region's very best wineries. The wine is aromatic, lively and fresh with a fabulous concentration of flavour. This will make you look at Soave in a whole new light. The Garganega vines are trained to give low yields with the wine spending around 15 months on fine lees before bottling.

	This is Pinot Grigio as you may have never seen before. Located in the German-speaking village of Magreid in the mountains of Alto Adige, Lageder runs his domaine on a completely sustainable basis. The vines (which have been farmed biodynamically since 2004) enjoy a long, sunny growing season with warm days and cool nights that help to preserve both the grapes' natural aromas and acidity. Aromas and flavours of pears, apples and elderflower, with hints of white pepper. This light-bodied white has a rich and smooth texture and a crisp finish and is made to meet the requirements of a Vegan diet.

	The hills above Trapani in north-western Sicily are home to the beautiful Fondo Antico vineyards. Temperature controlled fermentation and soft pressing of complete bunches takes place in stainless steel vats, delivering a wine that has a delicate bouquet of jasmine and floral aromas. (Don't worry, the vines don't miss the ocean winds because the high altitude keeps them at a steady cool temperature). However, Tomas left the family business in 2002, setting up his very own winery where he crafts incredibly fresh wines by using a variety of grape varieties and mixing up early picked fruit with riper, fruitier berries harvested later in the year. Tomas is involved in every part of the production; viticulture, viniculture and packaging, and his attention to detail is phenomenal. This range of varieties is to achieve two important things, natural acidity and aromatic intensity, and these wines have it in abundance. He is one of the most skilled blenders of wines we have come across. A blend of Macabeo & Sauvignon Blanc this unique modern Spanish wine has a very bright green and gold colour, a wide range of aromas, including apples, pears, mangos, apricots, orange flowers, citric notes, green grass and aromatic herbs like rosemary.	2013	Costers del Segre	Spain	38
2630	Vivanco Rioja Viura Malvasia Blanco Dinastia Vivanco is one of Rioja's leading producers, making modern styled Riojas with the focus firmly on bright, juicy fruit flavours. The Vivanco wines are made exclusively from the family's vineyards, where intimate knowledge of the sites enables them to create some superb Rioja, packed full of rustic charm and fresh fruit flavours. Made from white grapes sourced exclusively from their best vineyards in Briones and Haro with an average vine age of 21 years. After a brief cold maceration of the whole grape (no more than 12 hours), the free run juice was fermented at a controlled temperature of between 12 and 15°C to retain all the expression and complexity of both varietals. After a brief period in contact with its fine lees, the wine was drawn off ready for bottling. 2730	Riesling 'H' Rheingau Prinz von Hessen Donatus Prinz von Hessen is a very engaging and down-to-earth guy, and in fact genuinely royal (436th in line to the British throne), and his wines are great! Donatus took charge of the family estate in 2005 when it was going through a slightly difficult phase and turned its fortunes around - they decided to change everything and got rid of 30% of the vineyards. The estate has holdings in some of the best vineyards in the Rheingau with 20 of the 30ha of vines planted on first growth sites. They are located on a wide sweep of south-facing vineyards on the Rhine. The vineyards are protected from the north by the Taunus hills and warmed by the sun to the south. It is the very heart of fine German wine production, with the ancient Schloss Johannisberg (where Riesling was first planted in 1720) located just behind one of PVH's vineyard. This Vegetarian friendly wine has luscious mouthfuls of lemon, freshly cut green apples and delicate quince. Fruity but not sweet; refreshing but not tart.	2013	Rheingau	Germany	25
2740	Friendly Gruner-Veltliner Laurenz V Gruner Veltliner has effected a Cinderella-like transformation and now finds itself feted like a supermodel. Grapes are hand-harvested during the cool early morning hours to preserve the delicate flavours. Both Chardonnay and Pinot Noir flourish in Santa Lucia Highlands area of Monterey County with its cool climate and limestone soils.
